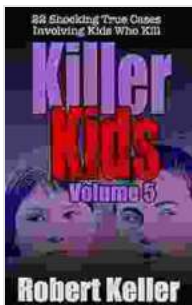

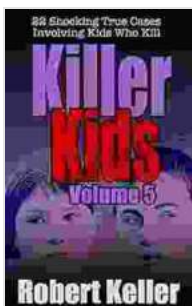
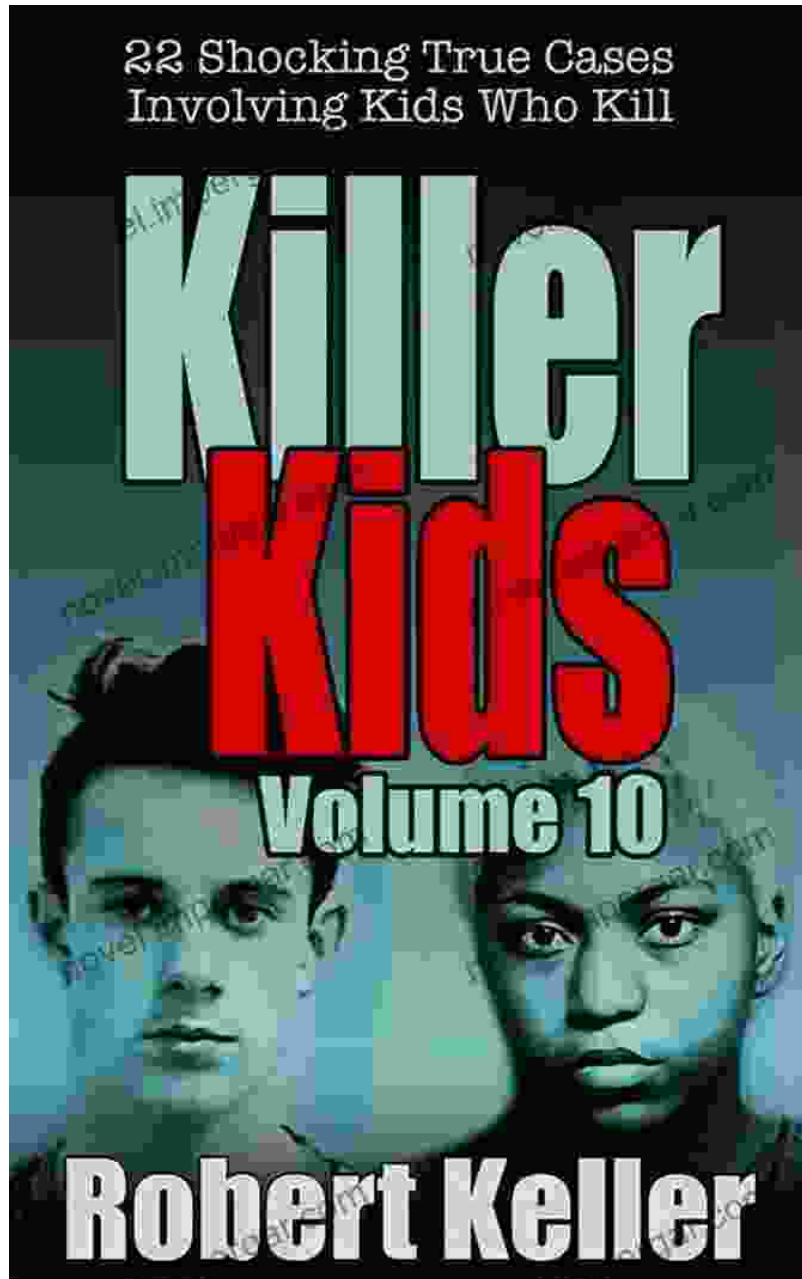
Venables and Thompson led Bulger away from a shopping mall and took him to a railway line. They tortured him for hours before finally killing him by smashing his head in with a brick.

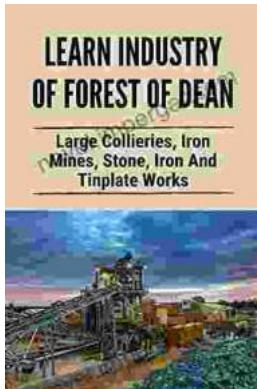

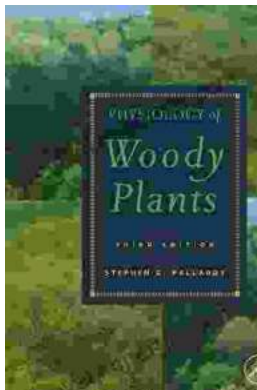
