
Beeswing: Losing My Way and Finding My Voice, 1967-1975



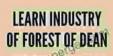

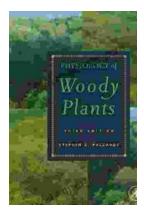
